#### PARADE RULES

1. **Only the vehicle pulling the float or other parade entries will be allowed into the Parade Line-up site. Unauthorized vehicles will be turned away. Please have candy or decorations in the vehicle also please have plenty of gas in the vehicle before entering the parade lineup site.**
2. Parade entries may not change their location in the Parade Line-up. Decorating must be completed by the start of the parade.
3. The Chamber is not responsible for any entries left unattended at the Parade Line-up site. Any animals entered in the parade must be completely supervised and controlled.
4. Adults must be present on any entry carrying children. No one under the age of 21 will be allowed to walk beside or near any float or vehicle.
5. Silly string is not permitted and will be confiscated.
6. Horses, mules, donkeys may be used to pull wagons, carriages, or buggies. No other horses, mules, or donkeys will be allowed.
7. Participants may not exit their float nor vehicle while parade is in motion. In addition, no one is allowed to ride or stand on running boards of automobile entries.
8. **All participants by signature below accepts full responsibility for all occupants of their float or vehicle and does hereby release The Houston County Area Chamber of Commerce/ City of Erin its employees and or agents from any and all liability resulting from damage or injury to the participant or their occupants during this event.**
9. **A copy of proof Insurance MUST be attached to this form for an entry into the Parade.**  
Entry fees pertain to certain individual entries, pageant winners or companies advertising a business or event. The fee will be \$25 per entry. Those seeking an elected office will have a fee of \$25. All fees must be paid in advance.
10. **NO Minors will be allowed to throw candy or other objects form cars , trucks or floats due to safety.**
11. **MUST BE 21 to drive and NO driver is allowed to throw candy this rule is for everyone's safety.**
